Submission for full papers (12 pages maximum) or posters (6 pages maximum) should be submitted electronically through the EDAS submission website in pdf format by midnight CET on July 1st, 2008. All submissions will be reviewed by three members of the international program committee.

To submit a proposal for a scientific demonstration, please submit a 2-page abstract through EDAS, containing a description of the demonstration, an explanation of its importance to the scientific community and the requirements for the demonstration (space, power and/or network connection).

As in the previous years, the proceedings including papers, posters and demo abstracts will be published at the VDE Verlag.
